

General Manager Report on District Activities
Board of Trustees Meeting
April 9, 2009

1. I sold the 40' Boom lift to the Marin-Sonoma Vector Control District.
2. I had the front walkway and two stairs repaired to satisfy ADA requirements.
3. I had the fence in the rear of the facility moved to the top of the berm in a location that meets County setback requirements. This was done to eliminate the continued toppling of the fence due to erosion from its placement in the middle of the berm. The new fence location also provides increased security. Gates and broken sections of barbed wire on other sections of the fence were also repaired.
4. Solicited quotes from multiple General Contractors for a remodel of the District's restrooms to meet ADA guidelines.
5. Sentinel chickens were picked up and distributed throughout the District's service area in preparation for a new year of disease surveillance.
6. Mosquito trapping began in several locations throughout the District's service area.
7. I solicited quotes from several sources regarding options for health care benefits. An in depth analysis must be performed before any recommendations can be made. Look for a discussion item on the next Board agenda.
8. Royce and I attended CEU training in San Diego on March 24th. This training fulfilled our CEU requirements for the current cycle.
9. Kenny, Royce, Donny and Karen attended the calibration day event on March 18th. One of our Argo's and the truck mounted fogger were calibrated for use should the need arise.
10. The old storage shed was cleaned out and disposed of clearing room for District vehicle parking and maneuverability.
11. I sent the Policy and Procedures manual to the District attorney on April 1st. He felt that I would have feedback before the Board meeting.
