

General Manager Report on District Activities
Board of Trustees Meeting
December 10, 2009

1. Attended the MVCAC Planning Session on December 3-4 at the Sacramento-Yolo Vector Control District. Topics discussed included the election of new committee liaisons, NPDES permitting process and timeline for completion, CEQA document updates, restructuring of the CMVCA Research Foundation board, the annual conference, other meeting dates, 2010 legislative days, mosquito awareness week, status of MVCAC sponsored legislation, review of committee chairs and committee charges, and the professional services agreement with Smith and Moore.
2. Purchased the 2010 Ford Fusion Hybrid from Perry Auto in Santa Barbara as directed.
3. Held interviews for the Administrative Assistant position on Monday, November 30th.
4. Continue to work out bugs and issues relating to the use of the new network; also continue to set up the preferences for the new database program.
5. Discussed possible options for the District property with Chief Mingee as a result of the Boards wishes following the November Board meeting.
6. Renewed badges for access to Santa Barbara Airport. Assigned Biologist as an Authorized Signatory in addition to the General Manager.
7. Submitted the revised Management plan for the Andree Clark Bird Refuge and other locations as requested by the City of Santa Barbara. As of the time of this writing I have not received formal notification of the acceptance or rejection of the proposal.
