

**General Manager Report on District Activities**  
**Board of Trustees Meeting**  
**March 12, 2009**

1. I sold the 2000 Chevy Astro Van for full asking price after advertising for only two days on Craig's List.
2. I had a dent in District truck # 66, which apparently had been there since long before my arrival, repaired.
3. I assisted the City of Santa Barbara Creeks Department in obtaining information regarding the proper design of class V injection wells to minimize mosquito production.
4. Royce and I attended CEU training in Garden Grove on March 4<sup>th</sup>, we will also be attending the CEU training in San Diego on March 24<sup>th</sup>. This will complete our requirements for the current cycle.
5. We will be picking up chickens in San Jacinto for the upcoming seasons disease surveillance program on March 17<sup>th</sup>.
6. I met with a representative from ICMA-RC to discuss the option of implementing a 457 deferred compensation plan for District staff. This is simply another retirement savings plan that staff may elect to utilize. There will be no cost to the District for this plan.
7. I contacted PARS to discuss GASB 45 compliance issues. They are providing me with contact information for an actuary who will do an analysis for \$1,500 which will get the ball rolling toward establishing a trust.
