

**General Manager Report on District Activities**  
**Board of Trustees Meeting**  
**May 14, 2009**

1. The 2007 F350 Super Duty has been placed under a consignment agreement with Mission City Auto Sales in Goleta. The company specializes in specialty work trucks.
2. I attended one day of the MVCAC Spring Quarterly Meeting in Visalia on Thursday, May 7, 2009. The main topics of discussion were NPDES permits, MVCAC's role if a law suit is filed against a member District, day at the District planning and the associations budget. .
3. The website has been updated; however, much work still needs to be completed. Plans include: Trustee and Staff bios, service request submission, Flash introductory page and educational information for kids.
4. Formulated the draft budget.
5. Developing the Districts application for an NPDES permit.
6. Contacted the City of Solvang regarding the placement of a sentinel chicken flock at the City's wastewater treatment facility. The City has been very cooperative and excited about the idea.
7. Worked with SCI in the development of the engineers report for the FY 2009-10 benefit assessments.
8. Solicited information from multiple health care providers in relation to the desire to change health care providers.
9. Solicited information from multiple sources for the implementation of a 457 deferred compensation plan as an added benefit for staff.
10. Implemented AFLAC insurance benefits for staff. This is a fully employee paid program with zero cost to the District.
11. Met with Lila Deeds of the Santa Barbara Retirement System regarding the District's retirement benefits and the possibility of piggybacking on the County's planned actuarial study for employers that participate in the County's retiree health plan.
