

Resolution No. 2009-03
A RESOLUTION OF THE MOSQUITO AND VECTOR MANAGEMENT DISTRICT OF SANTA BARBARA COUNTY REQUESTING ADDITIONAL RETIREMENT SERVICE CREDIT FOR EMPLOYEES SICK LEAVE BALANCES REMAINING AS OF THEIR DATE OF RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, adopted Ordinance No. 3784, on November 28, 1989, providing additional retirement service credit for employees sick leave balances remaining as of their date of retirement; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 31641.03. specifies, that such adoption by the Board of Supervisors does not apply to retirement system members employed by a district unless the governing body of said district provides, via resolution, for its application to such members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Mosquito and Vector Management District of Santa Barbara County that this district is an independent special district, as defined in section 56044 of the California Government Code, and is situated entirely within the County of Santa Barbara; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this district hereby requests, in compliance with Government Code Section 31641.03, that employees of said district who are active or deferred members of the Santa Barbara Retirement System on or after July 1, 1989, shall have their accumulated sick leave credit of up to 2,088 hours added to their term of service for purposes of calculating retirement benefits, and that members who also qualify under subsection (m) of this section may elect coverage under subsection (m) and/or subsection (n). However, no portion of accumulated sick leave may be accounted for simultaneously under subsection (m) & (n).
